Course Description

Experience in the major field to **develop knowledge and skills** in the practical application of theory to **actual problems in a non-classroom situation**. Developing **critical thinking skills**, identifying problems, and **analysis for solutions** will be an integral part of this course.

Requirements

- **60+** academic credits
- Approval from **Office of Internships & Co-Op Programs**
- Approval from an **academic advisor**
- **Pre-determined** eligible internship or co-op experience

Expectations

To receive credit for the internship, you are required to be registered for the course and **pay the required tuition/fees, complete all Canvas/Eagle Career Link assignments** and turn them in by the deadline, and **present yourself in a professional manner at all times**. You are **responsible for all materials and announcements** related to the course.

Elective Credit Options

- 1 credit = 45 hours of work
- 2 credits = 90 hours of work
- 3 credits = 135 hours of work
- 4 credits = 180 hours of work
- 5 credits = 225 hours of work
- 6 credits = 270 hours of work
- 7 credits = 315 hours of work
- 8 credits = 360 hours of work
- 9 credits = 405 hours of work
