


Creating a Global Resume:

When applying to foreign positions, students should become familiar with cultural and regional differences regarding resume format. Standard U.S. resumes are generally 1 page in length, feature only relevant work and post-secondary education. Depending on the location, however, international resumes may also include your photograph, birthdate, citizenship, brief biography, and a chronological list of all education, awards, and employment (relevant or not). International resumes are most often 2 pages in length—sometimes longer—and focus more on both your personality and professional accomplishments.

For help creating an international resume, first begin to narrow down the region where you would like to work. Reach out and talk to people who might be from that area to ask what their resume looks like. **For further assistance, schedule an appointment with a Career Advisor.**
