#### Important Notes:

- All prerequisite courses must be completed with a C or higher (a grade of C- is not acceptable).
- Degree seeking students are classified as pre-majors prior to formal transition into a COE major.
- In order to transition from a COE pre-major to a major, students must complete the following:
  - Submit an application for admission,
  - An overall GPA of 2.5 on all hours attempted
  - Pass all subsections of the FTCE General Knowledge Tet.
  - Satisfy General Education requirements.
  - Complete a minimum of sixty (60) credits.
  - Satisfy College-Level Skills requirement.
  - Satisfy common prerequisite requirements.
  - Successfully complete a background check.
  - Obtain liability insurance for field experiences in the PreK – 12 schools

Students are **strongly encouraged** to complete these courses as part of their AA degree to stay on track for a timely graduation. Any remaining prerequisite courses not completed during the AA may delay graduation.
