

Liability Insurance Information for New Admits to our COE Programs

Liability Insurance:

In order to participate in all field experiences, for all courses within the COE, COE students must obtain liability insurance.

You can do this through the [FEA/NEA Professional Liability Insurance](#) Program at the following website:

You will need to follow the prompts and create a new account to be a student member of the FFEA. By becoming a member of the FFEA, you will automatically receive insurance coverage to work in the schools and agencies. The insurance is valid for one academic year (June through the next August). **You will need to obtain current liability insurance each year you are enrolled in the COE.** The amount for the membership is \$31.00 and includes the insurance. In short, the liability insurance can be obtained easily through the website provided. Obtaining it only takes a few moments by creating an account online and paying the dues. Once you have obtained the insurance, you will need to print out the confirmation email that is sent to you and include it with your application.

Remember: you need to maintain and renew your annual membership in order to stay covered while you are enrolled in a COE program.
