## Pick the Sustainability 'low hanging fruit' at FGCU

- Recycle and garbage containers should always be together.
- In general classrooms with fewer than 50 seats will have neither garbage or recycle, but sets of bins should be visible as your exit any academic classroom.
- Labs, and lecture halls typically should have several sets of both recycle and garbage in the classroom  
(but they keep getting separated to prop open doors, etc

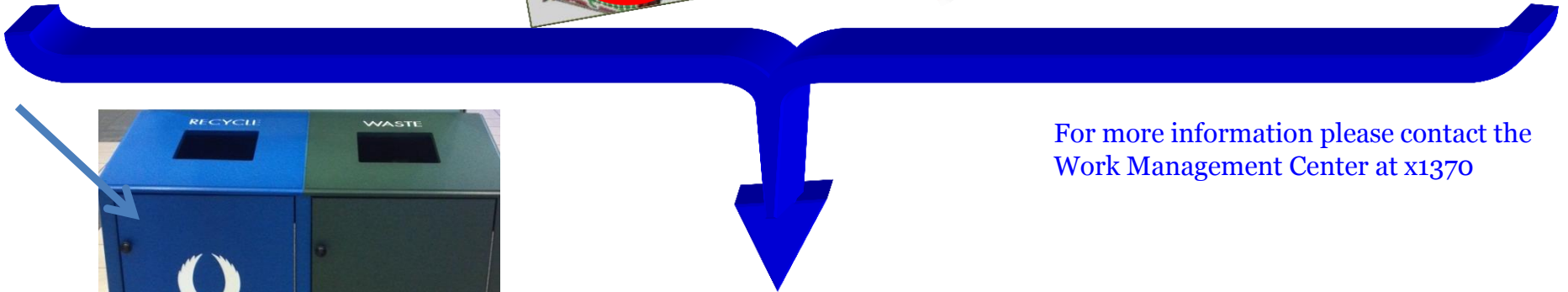
