(b) Student Affairs Team-Student Success and Enrollment Management Team

(i) Composition

The <u>Student Affairs Team_Student Success and Enrollment Management ("SS & EM") Team</u> consists of one faculty member representing each academic unit, one voting student member representing the SGA, and one ex officio member appointed by the Vice President of Student Affairs Success and Enrollment Management, and one ex-officio member appointed by the Provost and Vice President of Academic Affairs. Ad hoc members will participate as appropriate.

(ii) Responsibilities and Duties

The Student Affairs Team collaborates with Student Affairs on behalf of the faculty to develop policies affecting the quality of educational programs Student Success and Enrollment Management Team ("The Team") is the bridge between faculty and the Division of Student Success and Enrollment Management ("The Division") including its three areas: Enrollment Management, Academic Engagement (including advising, Service Learning, the Center for Academic Achievement, First Year Experience, Career Center, etc.) and Student Engagement (housing, campus life, recreation, Counseling and Psychological Services, etc.). The team-Team will share ideas, relevant concerns, developments, and other information between faculty and the Dvision and review and recommend policies concerning matters relating to student affairs student success that involve faculty. . These include, but are not limited to, (a) admission and readmission of students to the University, suspension of students, (b) withdrawal from courses and from the university, (c) academic status, (d) award of credit, (e) award of academic honors, (f) award of Student of the Year (SOTY), (g) student grievances, (h) educational equity, rights and responsibilities (including student code of conduct), and (i) review policies relating to academic integrity and student conduct. The team will work with Student Affairs to assure appropriate faculty representation on Student Services Committees. The Team will make sure the Division relays the voice of the faculty while supporting the Division Comprehensive Plan initiative to "Develop stronger partnerships with the academic programs and faculty".
