

INTRAMURAL SPORTS

FAQs

Q: What are Intramural Sports?

A: Intramural Sports are sports or activities put on by Campus Recreation in which FGCU students participate against other FGCU students. Teams are formed online at IMLeagues.com/FGCU and games are played throughout the academic year. Unlike high school sports or sport clubs, Intramural Sports are more recreational in nature and do not have mandated practices or events other than scheduled games.

Q: How do I register for a league or tournament?

A: All registrations are completed online. Visit IMLeagues.com/FGCU and click "login" in the upper right corner to begin the process. Then, when prompted, log-in with your Eagle email and Eagle email password (case sensitive). Using a non-FGCU email to log-in will result in being marked as ineligible.

Q: Who is allowed to participate in Intramural Sports?

A: Each participant must be a currently-enrolled student at FGCU or an active A&P faculty/staff member at FGCU. Participants are required to bring a valid Eagle ID or government-issued ID to all Intramural Sports activities to sign in. No ID, no play. Alumni and non-FGCU students are not permitted to participate in Intramural Sports.

Q: What do I need to participate in Intramural Sports?

A: Campus Recreation requires all Intramural Sports participants to wear athletic clothes and athletic shoes. Cleats are recommended for outdoor sports but not required. Metal cleats are prohibited. Campus Recreation will provide all necessary equipment to participate in each activity as well as a numbered jersey for participants to wear. Teams may wear their own t-shirts or jerseys if each participant on the team has his or her own number.

Q: If I win my league or tournament, what do I win?

A: All champions are given a champion t-shirt to commemorate their championship game victory.

Q: Can I sign up as a free agent if I don't want to create or join a team?

A: IMLeagues gives all participants the option to register as a free agent for a league. Registering as a free agent will put you on a public list and team captains will have the option of adding you to their team after that. Registering as a free agent does not guarantee that you will get to participate in the league you signed up for because Campus Recreation does not force teams to pick up free agents.

Q: Where are games played?

A: Almost all Intramural Sports games are played on FGCU's main campus. Outdoor sports are either played at Recreation Field 1 in the main campus loop or the Recreation Outdoor Complex near Alico Arena. Indoor sports are played inside Alico Arena.

Q: I've never played a sport before. Can I still register?

A: Absolutely. Participants do not need to have any previous experience playing to participate in Intramural Sports.

Q: My online account with IMLeagues is not working properly. What should I do?

A: Make sure that you are logging in with your Eagle email (with @eagle.fgcu.edu) and Eagle email password (case sensitive). If you have logged in with the proper credentials and are marked as ineligible or suspended, please email cbleich@fgcu.edu for additional help.
