



Prospective Sport Club Registration

All Registered Sport Clubs (RSC) start out as Registered Student Organizations (RSO) prior to joining the Sport Clubs Council. The Sport Clubs Council consists of a representative from each RSC and has an elected governing Executive Board (SCEB).

Prospective clubs must register as a Registered Student Organization. During the RSO registration process indicate interest in becoming an RSC in the designated section. Admission into the Sport Club Council is determined each year by the Sport Club Executive Board and the Campus Recreation Staff.

Registration Process

1. Complete RSO registration requirements, designating interest in joining the SCC.
2. Schedule meeting with the Sport Club Executive Board to discuss club status.
3. The risk associated with the participation of the sport will be assessed by the Campus Recreation Staff.
4. If approved, club probationary year must meet minimum requirements of the SCORE System.

Sport Club Organization Eligibility

Registered Sport Clubs affiliated with the Sport Club Council must meet the following standards:

- Goals of the club demonstrate a common mission between the club and the Sport Club Program.
- Must be sport in nature.
- Complete the Sport Club registration process once an academic year.
- Maintain a minimum of four (4) members.
- Maintain the following Officer Positions: President, Vice President, Treasurer.
- Officers must attend mandatory training each academic year.
- Maintain an organizational constitution.
- Must maintain minimum requirements of the SCORE System.
- Meets the standards of an acceptable risk level activity.

Risk Assessment

Upon the advice and consultation of other University officials and lawyers, the Department of Campus Recreation and the Sport Club Program retains the right to prohibit any sport or activity in which the risk of serious and/or fatal injury is deemed to be unacceptably high.

SCORE System

The FGCU Sport Clubs Official Report of Engagement (SCORE) System is in place to recognize the effort, hard work and overall involvement of Sport Clubs on an annual basis. The SCORE System evaluates Sport

Club involvement and engagement in a variety of categories in order to determine levels which impact a Sport Club's funding for the upcoming fiscal year, as well as a club's status as a Registered Sport Club.

The minimum requirements of the SCORE System to be completed within an academic year include:

1. **Roster:** Maintain at least 4 active club members.
2. **Fundraising:** Fundraise at least 15% of funds allocated to the club. If club is not awarded allocated funds, fundraising will be assessed based on the average Sport Club allocation for the year.
3. **Event Hosting & Travel:** Must host at least 1 home event or 1 approved trip related to the club's mission.
4. **Community Service:** The club must participate in at least 10 hours of community service.
5. **Attending Sport Club Events:** Must attend at least 1 other Sport Club's event.
6. **Administrative:** Must complete at least 30 points of administrative tasks including:
 - a. Have at least 3 Club Officers (President, Vice President & Treasurer) attend Officer Training.
 - b. Submit the Financial Report.
 - c. Provide an updated constitution on Eagle Link.
